Ogemaw Heights High School Summer School Guidelines 2021

Credit recovery provides students who have an academic failure with an opportunity to recover credit for that course. The required test(s) and projects/activities are established by each department. Students must have an overall percentage of **40% or better to qualify for summer school.** Proficiency testing will **not** be an option for students who fall below 45%. Students who fall below 40% need approval from their counselor and Mr. Doan. Options for credit recovery will be discussed with the counselors. **Proficiency testing is only available in the following areas: English, math, science, and social studies. Each of the subject areas must meet a minimum number of students in order to be held during the summer.**

Students need to complete the application and have parent/guardian sign the application. Please return the completed application to the counselors. Summer school registration will be by appointment on July 1, 2021. The sooner we know that students are interested in a summer school course the more chances there are for the subject area to be held during the summer school program.
