Wild Columbine Aquilegia canadensis



Light Needs: Columbine plants like to have partial shade in order to thrive.

Water Needs: Wild Columbine only needs to be watered once a week.

Average Landscape Size: The height depends on the location of the plants. In our area, the flower area of the plant is two inches, and the plant itself is one to three feet tall.

Key Feature: This plant has unique blossoms.

Blooms: Early to Mid-Summer

Landscape Uses: This plant is used to attract hummingbirds, bees, butterflies, and hawkmoths.
